Notice of Hearing for the Adoption and Amendment of Regulations of the Nevada Board of Osteopathic Medicine

The Nevada State Board of Osteopathic Medicine will hold a public hearing at **9:00 AM, on Saturday, November 15, 2008, at the offices of the Nevada Board of Osteopathic Medicine**, 2860 E. Flamingo Road, Suite D, Las Vegas, Nevada, 89121. The purpose of the hearing is to receive comments from all interested persons regarding the adoption and amendment of regulations that pertain to Chapter 633 of the Nevada Administrative Code.

The following information is provided pursuant to the requirements of NRS 233B.060.

Amendment of Nevada Administrative Code 633

1. The need for the purpose of the proposed regulation or amendment.

This language gives effect to NRS 633.434 which provides that the Board shall adopt regulations regarding the licensure of a physician assistant.

2. Either the terms of the substance of the regulations to be adopted and amended.

A copy of the proposed regulation, as amended by the Legislative Counsel Bureau, is attached to this notice.

3. The estimated economic effect of the regulation on the business which it is to regulate and on the public:

(a) Both adverse and beneficial effects.

There should be no adverse or beneficial economic effect on the business or the public.

(b) Both immediate and long-term effects.

There should be no immediate or long-term economic effect on the business or the public.

4. The estimated cost to the agency of enforcement of the proposed regulation.

There will be no additional cost incurred by the board for enforcement of this regulation.

5. A description of and citation to any regulations of other state or local governmental agencies which the proposed regulation overlaps or duplicates and a statement explaining why the duplication or overlapping is necessary. If the proposed regulation overlaps or duplicates a federal regulation, the notice must include the name of the regulating federal agency.

The Nevada State Board of Osteopathic Medicine is not aware of any regulations of other state or government agencies that the proposed regulation overlaps or duplicates.

6. If the regulation is required pursuant to federal law, a citation and description of the federal law.

The Nevada State Board of Osteopathic Medicine is not aware of any federal law requiring this regulation.

7. If the regulation includes provisions which are more stringent than a federal regulation that regulates the same activity, a summary of such provisions.

The Nevada State Board of Osteopathic Medicine is not aware of any similar federal regulations of the same activity in which the state regulation is more stringent.

8. Whether the proposed regulation establishes a new fee or increases an existing fee.

This regulation does not provide a new or increase of fees. This regulation changes the nomenclature of application for certification of a physician assistant to application for licensure for physician assistant, and physician assistant certificate renewal to physician assistant relicensure. The fee for initial application remains unchanged. The fee for renewal remains unchanged. These changes are mandate in NRS 633.434.

Persons wishing to comment upon the proposed action of the Board may appear at the scheduled public hearing or may address their comments, data, views, or arguments in written form to the Nevada State Board of Osteopathic Medicine, 2860 E. Flamingo Road, Suite D, Las Vegas, Nevada, 89121. Written submissions must be received by the Board at least fourteen days before the scheduled public hearing. If no person who is directly affected by the proposed action appears to request time to make an oral presentation, the Board may proceed immediately to act upon any written submissions.

A copy of this notice and the regulation to be adopted and amended will be on file at the State Library, 100 Stewart Street, Carson City, Nevada, for inspection by members of the public during business hours. Additional copies of the notice and regulation to be adopted and amended will be available in all counties in which an office of the agency is not maintained, at the main public library, for inspection and copying by members of the

public during business hours. The text of each regulation will include the entire text of any section of the Nevada Administrative Code which is proposed for amendment or repeal. This notice and the text of the proposed regulation are also available in the State of Nevada Register of Administrative Regulations which is prepared and published monthly by the Legislative Counsel Bureau pursuant to NRS 633B.0653, and on the internet at <http://www.leg.state.nv.us>. Copies of this notice and the proposed regulations will also be mailed to members of the public upon request. A reasonable fee may be charged for copies if it is deemed necessary.

Upon adoption of any regulation, the agency, if requested to do so by an interested person, either before adoption or within 30 days thereafter, will issue a concise statement of the principal reasons for and against its adoption, and incorporate therein its reason for overruling the consideration urged against its adoption.
