**VI. CONSIDERATION OF REQUEST FOR TEMPORARY LICENSURE FOR MICHAEL R. JENKINS, DO TO PRACTICE IN PAHRUMP NEVADA**

Walter J. Hoppe, DO has requested that Michael R. Jenkins, DO, be granted temporary licensure until September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2004, to allow for time for Dr. Jenkins to complete the application process.

The Board considered the request from Dr. Hoppe. However, since an application for a temporary license was not filed with the Board by Dr. Jenkins, there was nothing for the Board to act on since the minimum requirements for an application for a temporary license had not been met per statute. There was no application, and the fee had not been paid, therefore this request was denied.

The Board directed the Executive Office to notify Dr. Hoppe in writing of their denial of his request. Further, they ordered that the letter to Dr. Hoppe include the procedure necessary for Dr. Jenkins to apply for a license in this state.
