I Call to Order:

The meeting was called to order by Dr. Manthei - Chairman at 9:17AM. Mr. Kersey, Dr. Schreiber, Dr. Bannister, Dr. Daitch, Dr. Tarno, Jean Moriki-DAG, Wauna Selleck: guests from Medical Board- Dr. Skully, Jim Tracy, DDS.

II Approval of Minutes & Financial Report:

Dr. Tarno provided list of all checks written since January 1, 1998 which was reviewed. Dr. Manthei requested an estimate of Board funds following proposed changes in NRS with increasing fees and /or putting funds in a money market account.

There were no changes to minutes.

Dr. Skully representing the Medical Board was welcomed and asked that our Board attempt to be represented at a hearing regarding proposed changes to Regulations of the Homeopathic Board to be held in Carson City, June 26, 1998.

Dr. Tarno distributed the financial audit prepared by Mont Anderseon, CPA for 1995-9196 and 1996-1997.

Minutes of March 4, 1998 telephone conference meeting and February 1, 1998 meeting in Lake Tahoe were accepted without changes.

Financial report was accepted.

III Investigative Report Regarding Complaints: Investigative Report:

Dr. Manthei reported on one complaint that involved a Hospital complaining against a D.O. that was treating a patient with homeopathic remedy. There were no other significant new complaints. There were no new complaints

against doctors in the Northern part of the State since the last meeting in February.

V Legal Report:

Jean Moriki reported on 7 cases of complaints or investigations against D.O.s in her office. She is planning to reserve specific portions of time each week for dealing with each of the Boards or commissions she deals with.

Dr. Manthei asked status of the proposed changes in the Law we have make for the next legislative session. Dr. Tarno was asked to follow-up on that status the next week.

IX Adoption of Forms Regarding Child Support:

Dr. Tarno reported as previously discussed at the February meeting that SB 356 required the Board to include a form in each application and licensure renewal for attesting to child support information. The form presented was suggested by the office of the Attorney General. There was a brief discussion. Mr. Kersey made a motion to accept and adopt this form. Dr. Manthei seconded. Passed.

X Consumer Group Efforts to Expose "Bad Doctors":

Mr. Kersey discussed a situation of consumer groups that are trying to tabulate information on discipline of "bad" doctors. He has attended sessions on this topic at the Federation Annual Meeting. The A.G. office believes the file on any doctor should not contain any information regarding complaints or investigations since that constitutes confidential information. The original application, evidence of training and any copies of formal action against an application in another jurisdiction (public record) should be part of the public or non-confidential file. Confidential information should be kept separate. Dr. Tarno explained that requests for information on doctors of a public nature will be happily provided under written request.
