8 NOTICE OF HEARING

9 NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a complaint has been filed pursuant to Chapter 633
10 of the Nevada Revised Statutes and Chapter 633 of the Nevada Administrative Code,
11 charging you with (1) failure to report the federal plea agreement in which you admitted guilt
12 regarding the failure to remit taxes and (2) for unprofessional conduct and unethical conduct
13 regarding such tax issues, all of which conduct and/or acts may also constitute an unfitness to
14 practice osteopathic medicine in the State of Nevada.
15

16 A photocopy of the Complaint is being served on you along with this Notice of Hearing.

17 YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED that a hearing before the Hearing Officer for the
18 Nevada State Board of Osteopathic Medicine on the complaint shall commence as follows:

19 On the 5th of March, 2009, at the hour of 2:00 P.M., or as soon thereafter as it may be
20 heard on that date in the Offices of the State of Nevada Board of Osteopathic Medicine, 2860
21 E. Flamingo Road, Suite D, Las Vegas, NV 89121.

22 YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that you have the right to be heard and to appear in
23 person or by counsel and to present evidence and witnesses on your behalf at the aforesaid
24 time and place fixed for the hearing on the Complaint and charges.

25 YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that possible sanctions authorized in NRS 633.651
26 include:

- 28 A. Probation for a specified period or until further order of the Board.

- 1 B. A public reprimand.
- 2 C. Limitation of the practice to, or by exclusion of, one or more specified branches of
- 3 osteopathic medicine.
- 4 D. Suspension of the license to practice osteopathic medicine for a specified period
- 5 or until further order of the Board.
- 6 E. Revocation of the license to practice osteopathic medicine.
- 7 F. Any other terms, provisions, or conditions the Board deems proper and which are
- 8 not inconsistent with law.
- 9

10 Fines may also be assessed against you for each violation proven; and the Hearing
11 Officer may award fees and costs to the Board and against you.

12 YOU ARE ALSO NOTIFIED that, pursuant to NAC 633.460, you and/or your attorney
13 shall meet or confer with the Board's legal counsel, and the prosecuting attorney for the
14 Board, not later than 20 days before the hearing and exchange copies of all documents that
15 each party intends to offer as evidence in support of its case, identify describe or produce all
16 tangible things, other than documents, that each party intends to offer as evidence in support
17 of its case and, if requested, arrange for the opposing party to inspect, copy, test, or sample
18 such evidence under reasonable supervision, and exchange written lists of persons that each
19 party intends to call as witnesses in support of its case as outlined in NAC 633.460 (1)(c).

21 LASTLY, YOU ARE NOTIFIED that your failure to attend the hearing, or your failure to
22 defend yourself, shall not serve to delay or void the proceedings pursuant to NRS 622A.350.
23 Pursuant to NRS 622A.410, if your medical license is revoked, an order may be entered by
24 the Hearing Officer "prescribing [a period of time] in which [you] may not apply for

2 years."
