Please allow this letter to confirm our conversations of earlier today regarding the above-referenced matter. As we discussed, this matter has been settled under the following terms and conditions:

1. It is agreed that the above-referenced matter presently set for hearing on May 31, 2006 will be dismissed with prejudice, provided that you remit the sum of \$3,914.26 to the Nevada State Board of Osteopathic Medicine (hereinafter, the "BOARD") within thirty (30) days of tomorrow's date (i.e., on or before ~~June 30, 2006~~);

2. It is further agreed that this settlement does not contemplate any admission of liability on your part, nor will it be reported to any national databank as an instance of discipline against you;

3. It is further agreed that this matter will not be treated as an instance of prior discipline against you in any future disciplinary proceeding that may be commenced by the BOARD.

With regard to tomorrow's proceeding, it is my intention to set forth the terms of this settlement before Hearing Officer Lisa Miller Rocha. While you are certainly welcome to attend this brief discussion should you wish to do so, your appearance is not absolutely necessary. I mention this as an accommodation to your work schedule.


