**NOTICE OF 2<sup>nd</sup> & FINAL WORKSHOP**  
TO SOLICIT COMMENTS ON PROPOSED REGULATIONS FOR THE  
NEVADA STATE BOARD OF OSTEOPATHIC PHYSICIANS

**Workshop Notice:** The Nevada State Board of Osteopathic Medicine, 901 American Pacific Dr., # 180, Henderson, NV 89014, is proposing the amendment of regulations pertaining to Chapter 633 of the Nevada Administrative Code. A 2nd Workshop has been set for the purpose of soliciting comments from interested persons on the amendment of various regulations and the creation of new regulations.

The workshop will be conducted on Tuesday, January 26, 2010, at the hour of 5:30 P.M., or as soon thereafter as may be conducted on that date, at the Board's offices located at 901 American Pacific Dr., # 180, Henderson, NV 89014.

**Action – Proposed amendment to NAC Regulations**

The proposed amendments are necessary to clarify existing regulations and to implement new regulations as a result of the 2009 Nevada Legislative session. The proposed amendment will not have a direct economic effect on the business of the practice of medicine or any other business or on the public. Enforcement of the proposed amendments will not result in an increased cost to the Nevada State Board of Osteopathic Medicine. To the Board's knowledge, the proposed amendments do not overlap or duplicate the regulations of other state or local governmental agencies or any federal regulations. The proposed amendments do not establish any new fees or increases to existing fees. The proposed amendments do not affect small businesses in any way.

Persons wishing to comment on the proposed action may appear at the scheduled 2nd workshop or may address their comments, data, views or arguments, in written form, to the Nevada State Board of Osteopathic Medicine, 901 American Pacific Dr., # 180, Henderson, NV 89014. **Written submissions must be received by the Board on or before five (5) days prior to the date set for the workshop.
